Revocation Order

THE FOWL PEST (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1956

SPENT

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the provisions of the Fowl Pest Ordinances, 1949 and 1950, and of all other powers thereunto them enabling, hereby order:-

1. The Fowl Pest Order, 1956, is hereby revoked.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of June, 1956.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of this Order is that the restrictions on the movement of poultry into or out of the area within a radius of half-a-mile of the premises known as Newlyn's Poultry Farm, Les Fauconnaires, St. Andrew's, are withdrawn as from the 1st June, 1956.

Newlyn's Poultry Farm, however, remains an Infected Place under and for the purposes of the Fowl Pest Ordinances, 1949 and 1950.
