THE FUEL (MAXIMUM PRICES) (GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1956

Made 26th June, 1956
Coming into operation 1st July, 1956

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey, excluding the Island of Alderney, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey.

1. (1) The Schedule to the Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1956, is hereby revoked, and the Schedule to this Order is hereby substituted therefor.
- (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
2. This Order may be cited as the Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1956, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1956.
