SPENT

IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL)(GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL)(GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1955,
AMENDMENT NO. 2 ORDER, 1956

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of its powers under the Import and Export (Control)(Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955, Amendment Order, 1956, is hereby revoked.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into force on the 6th day of July, 1956, and may be cited as "The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955, Amendment No. 2 Order, 1956".

The effect of the above Order is that, as from the 6th July, 1956, there will be no restrictions on the exportation of poultry, dead or alive, to the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man.
