The Quarries (Safety) Regulations, 1956

Made .. .. . 24th October, 1956  
Coming into operation .. 1st November, 1956

THE STATES LABOUR AND WELFARE COMMITTEE, as the Administering Authority constituted by the States under the Health, Safety and Welfare of Employees Law, 1950, and in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the Quarries (Safety) Ordinance, 1954, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Interpretation

1. (1) In these Regulations the expression "the Ordinance" means the Quarries (Safety) Ordinance, 1954.
- (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

Particulars as to young persons employed

2. For the purpose of subsection (1) of section forty-eight of the Ordinance, the particulars as to the young persons employed at a quarry to be entered in or attached to the general register kept in pursuance of the provisions of that subsection shall be the following, that is to say:-
  - (a) the Christian names and surname of any young person employed at the quarry;
  - (b) the date of birth of such person;
  - (c) the residence of such person;
  - (d) the date of any commencement of employment of such person at the quarry; and
  - (e) the date of any termination of employment of such person at the quarry.

Citation and commencement

3. (1) These Regulations may be sited as the Quarries (Safety) Regulations, 1956, and these Regulations and the Quarries (Safety) Regulations, 1954, may be cited together as the Quarries (Safety) Regulations, 1954 and 1956.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of November, nineteen hundred and fifty-six.
