GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1956 - No. 27

The Safety of Employees Regulations, 1956

Made 24th October, 1956
Coming into operation .. 1st November, 1956

THE STATES LABOUR AND WELFARE COMMITTEE, as the Administering Authority constituted by the States under the Health, Safety and Welfare of Employees Law, 1950, and in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the Safety of Employees (Miscellaneous Provisions) Ordinance, 1952, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Interpretation

- 1. (1) In these Regulations the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:-

"factory" has the same meaning as in the Ordinance and includes any building operation and any premises whatsoever to which the Ordinance applies;

"the Ordinance" means the Safety of Employees (Miscellaneous Provisions) Ordinance, 1952.

- (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

Particulars as to young persons employed

- 2. For the purpose of subsection (1) of section seventy-three of the Ordinance, the particulars as to the young persons employed in a factory to be entered in or attached to the general register kept in pursuance of the provisions of that subsection shall be the following, that is to say:-

- (a) the Christian names and surname of any young person employed in the factory;
- (b) the date of birth of such person;
- (c) the residence of such person;
- (d) the date of any commencement of employment of such person in the factory; and
- (e) the date of any termination of employment of such person in the factory.

Citation and commencement

- 3. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Safety of Employees Regulations, 1956, and these Regulations and the Safety of Employees Regulations, 1953, may be cited together as the Safety of Employees Regulations, 1953 and 1956.

- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of November, nineteen hundred and fifty-six.
