Order designating a Competent Authority in relation to  
Regulation fifty-five of the Defence (General) (Guernsey)  
Regulations, 1945

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE, as Competent Authority in relation to Regulation fifty-five of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, hereby orders:-

1. The President or the person for the time being acting as President of the States Committee for Horticulture is hereby designated as a Competent Authority in relation to Regulation fifty-five of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, as respects the Island of Guernsey in relation to petroleum and petroleum products, other than motor spirit, to be utilised in horticulture.

2. In this Order the expression "motor spirit" means hydrocarbon oils of which not less than fifty per centum by volume distils at a temperature not exceeding 185° Centigrade, or of which not less than ninety-five per centum by volume distils at a temperature not exceeding 240° Centigrade, or which give off an inflammable vapour at a temperature of less than 22.8° Centigrade when tested in a manner prescribed by the Acts of the United Kingdom relating to petroleum, for use in a spark ignition engine.
