The Safety of Employees (Growing Properties)
Regulations, 1955

THE STATES LABOUR AND WELFARE COMMITTEE, as the Administering Authority constituted by the States under the Health, Safety and Welfare of Employees Law, 1950, and in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by the Safety of Employees (Growing Properties) Ordinance, 1954, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Interpretation

1. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:-

"the Authority" means the Administering Authority constituted by the States under the Health, Safety and Welfare of Employees Law, 1950;

"the Factories Act" means the Factories Act, 1937;

"the Ordinance" means the Safety of Employees (Growing Properties) Ordinance, 1954.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

Air Receivers

2. For the purposes of subsection (5) of section six of the Ordinance -

(a) the form of report of the result of an examination of an air receiver shall be Form 59 prescribed by the Secretary of State under section thirty-one of the Factories Act and for the said purposes the reference in the said Form 59 to section thirty-one of the Factories Act shall be construed as a reference to section six of the Ordinance; and the particulars to be contained on the said form shall be the particulars referred to on the said Form 59;

(b) the form of supplementary report of the result of an examination of an air receiver shall be Form 60 prescribed by the Secretary of State under sections thirty and thirty-one of the Factories Act and for the said purposes the reference in the said Form 60 to sections thirty and thirty-one of the Factories Act shall be construed as a reference to section six of the Ordinance; and the particulars to be contained on the said form shall be the particulars referred to on the said Form 60.

Register of Protected Workers

3. The form of the register of protected workers required under section twenty-eight of the Ordinance to be kept by an employer shall be a book in the form set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

Notification of Accidents

4. For the purposes of subsection (1) of section twenty-nine of the Ordinance the form of written notice of an accident to which that section applies shall be Form 1 prescribed by the Authority under section fifty-seven of the Safety of Employees (Miscellaneous Provisions) Ordinance, 1952, and for the said purposes the reference in the said Form 1 to section fifty-seven of the Safety of Employees (Miscellaneous Provisions) Ordinance, 1952, shall be construed as a reference to section twenty-nine of the Ordinance.

Citation and Commencement

5. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Safety of Employees (Growing Properties) Regulations, 1955.
(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the third day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-five.
