IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949,
AMENDMENT ORDER, 1955

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of its powers under the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a), as amended, shall be further amended by the deletion therefrom of the following items:-

"Ham, other than canned".

"Fruit, canned or bottled of the following varieties:-
Apricots, peaches, pears and any mixture of such fruits other than those exported through the normal postal services".

"Fish, canned of the following varieties:-
Crab, Salmon (including Salmon Trout), other than Smoked Salmon in oblong cans, not containing more than 4 ozs. in weight".

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into force on the 9th day of February, 1955, and may be cited as "The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment Order, 1955.

Explanatory Note

The effect of the above Order is that as from the 9th February, 1955, there will be no restrictions on the exportation to the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick and the Isle of Man, of ham, other than canned; canned or bottled apricots, peaches or pears and any mixture of these fruits; canned crab and canned salmon.
