IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949,  
AMENDMENT NO. 2 ORDER, 1955

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of its powers under the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a), as amended, shall be further amended by the deletion therefrom of the following item:-

"Milk, condensed".

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into force on the 18th day of February, 1955, and may be cited as "The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 2 Order, 1955."

Explanatory Note

The effect of the above Order is that as from the 18th February, 1955, there will be no restrictions on the exportation of condensed milk to the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick and the Isle of Man.
