AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE

*revoked by S.I. 1955
No 16*

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated the 3rd August, 1949, (a), as amended, the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick, or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the Board of Administration.

Now, therefore, the Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. The Open General Import Licence dated the 27th July, 1954, as amended, shall be further amended in accordance with Appendices I and II hereto.
2. This amendment shall take effect on the 18th day of February, 1955, and may be modified or revoked at any time by the Board of Administration.
