IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946.

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949

AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL EXPORT LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated the 3rd August, 1949, (a) as amended, the exportation from Guernsey of goods consigned to a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the Board of Administration.

Now, therefore, the Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. The Open General Export Licence dated the 30th November, 1954, shall be amended in accordance with the Schedule hereto.
2. This amendment shall take effect on the 8th day of April, 1955, and may be modified or revoked at any time by the Board of Administration.
