IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1955

AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955, dated the 14th June, 1955, (a), the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick, or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the Board of Administration.

Now, therefore, the Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. The Open General Import Licence dated the 27th July, 1954, as amended, shall be further amended in accordance with the Appendix hereto.
2. This amendment shall take effect on the 15th day of July, 1955, and may be modified or revoked at any time by the Board of Administration.
