THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1955

AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955, dated the 14th June, 1955, (a), the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the Board of Administration.

Now, therefore, the Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. The Open General Import Licence dated the 23rd August, 1955, shall be amended in accordance with the Appendix hereto.
2. This amendment shall take effect on the 7th day of October, 1955, and may be modified or revoked at any time by the Board of Administration.

APPENDIX

After Article (1)(h) insert the words:-

"Provided that the inclusion of any goods in that Schedule shall not affect any provision in any other paragraph to this licence authorising the importation of those goods."

SCHEDULE VIII

Part B.

After the item:-

Feathers of birds and articles consisting wholly or partly of feathers

insert:-

NOTE. Certain feathers and articles made therefrom may be imported from countries including those specified at the head of this Schedule (see Schedule III Group 4).

After the item:- Fish, fresh, frozen or preserved; not packed in airtight containers.

insert:-

NOTE. Fish may, subject to certain conditions, be imported from countries including those specified at the head of this Schedule. (See Schedule III Group 1, Schedule I and Schedule X).

After the item:- Fruit, bottled, and fruit pulp (including bulk frozen fruit), of the following varieties:-

Apricot.
Grapefruit.
Peach.
Pear.
Pineapple.
Any mixture of these varieties.

insert:-

NOTE. Bottled fruit and fruit pulp of these varieties may, subject to certain conditions, be imported from countries including those specified at the head of this Schedule. (See Schedule III Group 1 and Schedule V).

After the item:- Fruit, canned, other than canned grapes.

insert:-

NOTE. Canned fruit of certain varieties may, subject to certain conditions, be imported from countries including those specified at the head of this Schedule. (See Schedule III Group 1 and Schedule V).

After the item:- Gold, wrought.

insert:-

NOTE. Gold bullion and gold coin may be imported from all countries. (See Schedule I).

After the item:- Jute manufactures, the following:-

Piece goods.
Sacks and bags.
Twist.
Yarn.

insert:-

NOTE. Certain narrow fabrics and secondhand sacks and secondhand bags may be imported from countries including those specified at the head of this Schedule. New sacks and bags may be imported from the Irish Republic. (See Schedule III Group 6 and Schedule VII).

After the item:- Meats, fresh, chilled or frozen, except:-

Donkey.
Goat.
Horse.
Mule.

insert:-

NOTE. Certain meats, fresh, chilled or frozen, may be imported from countries including those specified at the head of this Schedule. (See Schedule III Group 1).
