THE MILK (CONTROL AND RATIONING) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1947,
(AMENDMENT NO. 7) ORDER, 1953.

Made 30th December, 1953.
Coming into Operation ... 1st January, 1954.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, the President of the States' Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities and the States Dairy Committee, hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Milk (Control and Rationing) (Guernsey) Order, 1947, as amended, shall be further amended by deleting from Part 8 thereof, paragraph 2 of Article 17.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. The General Licence dated 20th May, 1950 (a) issued under the Milk (Control and Rationing) (Guernsey) Order, 1947, is hereby revoked.
4. This Order may be cited as The Milk (Control and Rationing) (Guernsey) Order, 1947, (Amendment No. 7) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1954.
