AUTHORISATION UNDER SECTION TWO OF THE ELECTRICITY LAW 1933

TEMPORARY MODIFICATIONS ORDINANCE, 1943.

I, Arthur Falla, President of the States Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities, in pursuance of section two of the Electricity Law 1933 Temporary Modifications Ordinance, 1943, do hereby authorise the substitution - for the requirements of those provisions of section thirty-one of the Law entitled "Loi relative à la Fourniture de l'Electricité par les Etats, 1933", which provide that any electrical apparatus fixed or placed in any premises to which electrical energy is or is about to be supplied by the States Electricity Board shall not be used unless and until such apparatus has been examined, tested and approved by an inspector appointed by the said Board as complying with the requirements for the time being of the Institution of Electrical Engineers of London as set forth in the rules and regulations for the electrical equipment of buildings issued by that Institution and that any such apparatus after the same or any part thereof has been altered in position or in extent or by replacement or repair shall not be used unless and until it has been examined, tested and approved as aforesaid - of the requirement that any electrical apparatus fixed or placed as aforesaid shall not be used after it has been fixed or placed as aforesaid or after the same or any part thereof has been altered in position or in extent or by replacement or repair unless and until its use has been approved by or on behalf of the said Board.
