THE IMPORTED EGGS (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1954.

Made 7th January, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 10th January, 1954.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. (1) The Imported Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended by substituting for the Schedule thereto, the Schedule to this Order.
- (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
2. The Imported Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1953, dated 23rd December, 1953 (c) is hereby revoked.
3. This Order may be cited as The Imported Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 10th day of January, 1954.
