

THE GENERAL FOOD (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 10) ORDER, 1954.

Made 8th February, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 21st February, 1954.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended as follows:-
 - (a) by substituting in the second column of Part VII - Fats, of the Schedule thereto, for the entry "3s. Od." relating to Butter, imported, the entry "3s. 4d."
 - (b) by substituting in the second column of Part IX - Cheese, of the Schedule thereto, for the entry "2s. Od." the entry "2s. 2d."
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 10) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 21st day of February, 1954.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order has the effect of increasing the maximum retail price of National Butter by 4d. per lb. and the maximum retail price of Cheese, to which the principal Order applies, by 2d. per lb.
