THE FATS AND CHEESE (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 8) ORDER, 1954.

Made 8th February, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 21st February, 1954.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Fats and Cheese (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953 (a) as amended (b), shall be further amended as follows:-
 - (a) by deleting from the second column of the entries relating to butter in the table in the Schedule to the said Order the words "in each odd numbered ration week and 2 oz. in each even numbered ration week";
 - (b) by substituting in the third column of the said entries for the reference to the weight "3 oz." a reference to the weight "4 oz."
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Fats and Cheese (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 8) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 21st day of February, 1954.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order, which comes into force on 21st February, 1954 -

- (a) increases from 2 oz. to 4 oz. in each even numbered ration week the amount of butter obtainable against the appropriate coupon in a General Ration Book R.B.1 and a Child's Ration Book R.B.2. The ration for each odd numbered ration week remains at 4 oz;
- (b) increases from 3 oz. to 4 oz. the amount of butter obtainable against each appropriate coupon in a Temporary Ration Card R.B.12.
