THE COAL (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT)
ORDER, 1954.

Made 24th February, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 1st March, 1954.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Coal Rationing Order, 1946, shall be amended by deleting from paragraph 2 of Article I thereof, which gives the definition of Coal, the word "Coke" wherever it appears.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. The following Orders are hereby revoked:-
 - (1) The Coke (Temporary Relaxation) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1947, dated 8th November, 1947.
 - (2) The Coke (Temporary Relaxation) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1949, dated 3rd January, 1949.
4. This Order may be cited as the Coal (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of March, 1954.
