IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949,
Amendment Order, 1954.

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of its powers under the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The First Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a), as amended, shall be further amended by the deletion therefrom of the following items:-

"Boxboards and Timber for converting into Boxboards".

"Doors, wooden".

"Timber, raw".

"Wines and Spirituous Liquors other than wines and spirituous liquors being the produce of the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey or the Isle of Man".

2. The Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a), as amended, shall be further amended as follows:-

- (i) There shall be deleted therefrom the items:-

"Builders' Goods of the following description:-

Cast iron pipes, (including greenhouse heating pipes).

Cement.

Galvanised Sheet Iron.

Iron and Steel (cast iron, iron bars, rolled steel sections and sheets).

Wall-paper.

Wood window frames.

Wooden doors".

"Eggs".

"Gas Apparatus, Appliances and Equipment of every description, and parts and fittings therefor".

"Wines and Spirituous Liquors".

"Cream".

"Fruit, dried".

"Nuts, edible".

"Poultry, dead".

"Shredded Suet".

"Meat and Meat Products, including Poultry, cooked, canned or in other airtight containers".

"Fruit, bottled (in water, syrup or spirituous liquor)".

- (ii) There shall be substituted for the item -

"Meat and Meat Products, cooked, other than canned or in other airtight containers"

the item - "Ham, other than canned".

- (iii) There shall be substituted for the item -

"Fruit, canned".

the item - "Fruit, canned or bottled of the following varieties:- Apricots, Peaches, Pears and any mixture of such fruits".

(iv) There shall be substituted for the item -

"Fish, canned".

the item - "Fish, canned, of the following varieties:-

Crab, Salmon (including Salmon Trout), other than Smoked Salmon in oblong cans not containing more than 4 ozs. in weight".

3. The Delegation of Power to grant Import Licences (No. 1.) Order, 1949, (b), as amended, shall be further amended by the deletion therefrom of the words -
"and Wines and Spirituous Liquors"
"For Boxboards and Timber for converting into Boxboards, to the States' Committee for Horticulture"
"For Raw Timber and Wooden Doors to the States Housing Authority".
4. The Delegation of Power to grant Export Licences (No. 1.) Order, 1949, (c) as amended, shall be further amended by the deletion therefrom of the words -
"For Builders' Goods, Gas Apparatus, Appliances and Equipment, and Iron and Steel Scrap; to the States Housing Authority".
"Wines and Spirituous Liquors".
5. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
6. This Order shall come into force on the 11th March, 1954, and may be cited as the "Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment Order, 1954".

Explanatory Note

The effect of the above Order is that as from 11th March, 1954, there will be no restrictions on the importation from the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick and the Isle of Man of the items included in Section 1 of the Order, and also on the exportation to these places of the items included in Section 2 (i).

Export to any destination of the amended items in Sections 2 (ii), 2 (iii) and 2 (iv) is prohibited except under the authority of an Export Licence granted by the States Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities.
