THE IMPORTED ANIMAL FEEDINGSTUFFS (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1954.

Made 7th April, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 10th April, 1954.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953 (a) shall be amended as follows:-
 - (a) by deleting in the definition of "animal" in paragraph (1) of Article 1 the words "any cow and any bull".
 - (b) by deleting in the definition of "feedingstuff" in paragraph (1) of Article 1 thereof, sub-paragraphs (b) and (c).
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 10th day of April, 1954.
