expiredTHE MILK PRICES (GUERNSEY) (NO. 1) ORDER, 1954.

The States Dairy Committee as Competent Authority in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Order in Council, 1946, and pursuant to a Resolution of the States of the 28th April, 1954, fixing the prices of milk during the period 1st May, 1954 to 30th April, 1955, hereby makes the following Order :-

1. The price payable by the States Dairy Committee (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") in respect of locally produced cows' milk purchased by the Committee and subsequently classified as Grade I milk and which is not surplus to the Island's liquid milk requirements from time to time shall be as follows :-

18th July, 1954 to 20th November, 1954, inclusive	2/4 th d.
21st November, 1954 to 10th March, 1955, inclusive	2/7 th d.
20th March, 1955 to 30th April, 1955, inclusive	2/1 st d.

subject, however, to such variations in price as may be determined by the Committee in order to give effect to the States decision that a basic average price of 2/4thd. per pot in respect of milk which is not surplus to the Island's liquid milk requirements shall be paid to milk producers, collectively, in respect of the period 1st May, 1954 to 30th April, 1955, inclusive.

2. The price payable by the Committee in respect of surplus locally produced cows' milk purchased by the Committee shall be at such reasonable commercial rate per pot as the Committee shall from time to time determine, and any surplus shall be deemed to have been produced by all milk producers, and payment therefor shall be made in proportion to the quantity of milk sent to the Dairy by individual producers (vide States Resolutions L.B.2(2) and L.B.2(3) of 30th April, 1952).
3. The price to be paid by retailers to the Committee as regards whole cows' milk, whether produced locally or imported, shall be at the rate of 2/1std. per pot during the twelve months period commencing on 1st May, 1954.
4. The price to be paid by consumers to retailers as regards whole cows' milk, whether produced locally or imported and whether delivered at the residence of the consumer or fetched by the consumer, shall be at the rate of 7thd. per pint during the twelve months period commencing on 1st May, 1954.
5. This Order may be cited as The Milk Prices (Guernsey) (No. 1) Order, 1954, and shall have effect on and after the 1st day of May, 1954.
