Revocation Order

SPENT

THE IMPORTED ANIMAL FEEDINGSTUFFS (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1954.

Made 6th May, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 9th May, 1954.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The following Orders are hereby revoked, but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof:-
 - (1) The Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953, dated 26th October, 1953 (a).
 - (2) The Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1954, dated 7th April, 1954 (b).
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 9th day of May, 1954.
