THE FOOD RATIONING (GENERAL PROVISIONS) (BAILLIWICK
OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER, 1954.

Made 14th May, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 16th May, 1954.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excludng the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended as follows:-
 - (a) by deleting from sub-paragraph (a) of the definition of ration document in paragraph (1) of Article 1 of the Order the words "or of the Food Rationing (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Orders, 1952";
 - (b) by substituting in paragraph (4) of Article 1 thereof for the words "17th day of May, 1953" the words "16th day of May, 1954";
 - (c) by deleting from sub-paragraph (a) of Article 4 thereof the words "or a form R.G.44";
 - (d) by deleting from paragraph (3) of Article 5 thereof the proviso thereto;
 - (e) by substituting in paragraph (1) of Article 6 thereof for the words "coupons from a General Ration Book R.B.1, Child's Ration Book R.B.2, or Ration Book R.B.7" the words "coupons for meat from a Ration Book R.B.7";
 - (f) by deleting from sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (1) of Article 14 thereof the words "or a form R.G.44";
 - (g) by substituting for paragraph (5) of Article 18 thereof the following paragraph:-

"(5) Any appropriate coupon printed on both sides of the paper shall count as one coupon only."
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 16th day of May, 1954.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order makes a number of minor incidental amendments consequential upon the continued use after 15th May, 1954, of the 1953/54 ration documents in relation to the remaining rationed foods, meat and bacon. In addition certain deletions from the Principal Order have been made because of the de-rationing of butter, margarine and cooking fats.

The only coupons which may be deposited in advance with a retailer after 15th May, 1954, are meat coupons from a Ration Book R.B.7.
