THE GAS CHARGES (GUERNSEY) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1954.

Made 25th May, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 30th May, 1954.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Gas Charges (Guernsey) Order, 1953 dated 2nd March, 1953 (a) is hereby revoked.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Gas Charges (Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 30th day of May, 1954.
