THE MEAT (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)  
(NO. 2) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1954.

Made ... .. 8th June, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 9th June, 1954.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Meat (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) Order, 1953 (a), as amended (b), shall be further amended as follows:-
  - (a) in Part I of the Schedule there shall be substituted for the heading "1st Quality Home-killed and Imported", the heading "1st Quality Imported.";
  - (b) in Part I of the Schedule there shall be substituted for the heading "Imported, Frozen and 2nd Quality Home-killed", the heading "Imported, Frozen.";
  - (c) there shall be added to Part I of the Schedule, the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Meat (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 9th day of June, 1954.
