Revocation Order

THE IMPORTED EGGS (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)  
(REVOCATION) ORDER, 1954.

Made ... .. 21st June, 1954.  
Coming into operation ... 24th June, 1954.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The following Orders are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof:-
  - (1) The Imported Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953 (a).
  - (2) The Imported Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1954 (b).
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Imported Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 24th day of June, 1954.
