THE ANIMAL PRODUCTS IMPORTATION ORDER, 1954

The States of Guernsey Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section ten of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. (1). The importation of meat, including edible offal, into the Island from the Argentine, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Denmark, Holland, Switzerland or Uruguay shall be permitted if the meat was first landed in Great Britain.
- (2). Any cloth, wrapping, sacking or other material which has been used for or in connection with the wrapping of meat, including edible offal, imported under the provisions of the last preceding subsection shall, on arrival in the Island, be destroyed at the importer's expense in such manner as may be prescribed by the States Supervisor.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 12th July, 1954.
