THE IMPORTED CARROTS (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (GUERNSEY)
(REVOCATION) ORDER, 1954.

Made 1st July, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 4th July, 1954.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Imported Carrots (Maximum Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1949 (a), is hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Imported Carrots (Maximum Retail Prices) (Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 4th day of July, 1954.
