Revocation Order

THE VEGETABLES (RECORDS AND DISPLAY OF PRICES)  
(GUERNSEY) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1954.

SPENT

Made ... .. 1st July, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 4th July, 1954.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Vegetables (Records and Display of Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1949 (a), is hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Vegetables (Records and Display of Prices) (Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 4th day of July, 1954.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order removes the necessity for -

- (1) the keeping of records by wholesalers and retailers of all purchases and sales of fresh vegetables;
- (2) the display by retailers of the prices of all fresh vegetables offered or exposed for sale; and
- (3) the marking of all imported fresh vegetables as such.
