REVOCATION OF GENERAL LICENCES MADE BY THE STATES' COMMITTEE FOR THE CONTROL OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES UNDER THE FLOUR (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1953.

Made ... .. 1st July, 1954.  
Coming into Operation ... 4th July, 1954.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The following General Licences issued under the Flour (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953 (a) are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof:-
  - (1) The General Licence dated 31st August, 1953 (b).
  - (2) The General Licence dated 29th September, 1953 (c).
  - (3) The General Licence dated 27th October, 1953 (d).
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as Revocation of General Licences made by the States' Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities under the Flour (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 4th day of July, 1954.
