IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949,  
AMENDMENT NO. 4 ORDER, 1954

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of its powers under the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The First Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a) as amended, shall be further amended by the deletion therefrom of the following item -

"potatoes"

2. The Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended by substituting for the item -

"Fruit, canned or bottled of the following varieties:- apricots, peaches, pears and any mixture of such fruits"

the item -

"Fruit, canned or bottled of the following varieties:- apricots, peaches, pears and any mixture of such fruits other than those exported through the normal postal services"

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into force on 11th July, 1954, and may be cited as the "Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 4 Order, 1954".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of the above Order is that as from 11th July, 1954, there will be no restrictions on the importation of potatoes from the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick and the Isle of Man, and no restrictions on the exportation to the same places of canned or bottled apricots, peaches, pears and any mixture of these fruits when the exportation is made through the normal postal services.

Importations of potatoes, however, remain subject to the provisions of the Plants and Potatoes Importation Ordinances 1951 and 1953 as far as health certification is concerned.
