

THE FOOD (LICENSING OF ESTABLISHMENTS) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1954.

Made 1st July, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 4th July, 1954.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Food (Licensing of Establishments) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1948 (a) and the Food (Licensing of Establishments) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1954 (b), are hereby revoked, but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Food (Licensing of Establishments) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 4th day of July, 1954.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

This Order revokes the Food (Licensing of Establishments) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1948, as amended, which required persons carrying on certain catering establishments to hold a Catering Licence.
