Revocation Order

THE FISH (RECORDS AND DISPLAY OF PRICES) (BAILLIWICK  
OF GUERNSEY) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1954.

Made ... .. 1st July, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 4th July, 1954.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Fish (Records and Display of Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (a), is hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Fish (Records and Display of Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 4th day of July, 1954.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order removes the necessity for -

- (1) the keeping of records by retailers of all purchases of fish;
- (2) the display by retailers of the prices of all fish offered for sale; and
- (3) the marking of all imported fish as such.
