Revocation Order

THE IMPORTED WARE POTATOES (MAXIMUM PRICES) (GUERNSEY)
(REVOCATION) ORDER, 1954.

Made 10th July, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 12th July, 1954.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Imported Ware Potatoes (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a) and the Imported Ware Potatoes (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1954 (b) are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Imported Ware Potatoes (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 12th day of July, 1954.
