SPENT

THE FOOD (LICENSING OF RETAILERS) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)  
(REVOCATION) ORDER, 1954.

Made ... .. 28th July, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 1st August, 1954.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Food (Licensing of Retailers) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952 (a) is hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Food (Licensing of Retailers) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1954, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of August, 1954.
