TRAFFIC REGULATIONS. (No. 1 of 1954). STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1954 No. 76.

The Island Police Committee acting under the powers conferred on them by the Traffic Regulations Ordinance, 1939, hereby give notice that as from 23th October, 1954, the following regulations shall be in operation until 23th December, 1954. This Regulation is made in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island.

ONE WAY TRAFFIC.

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, proceed with that vehicle or animal or permit that animal to proceed on or along :-

that portion of Guelles Road, St. Peter Port, from the junction of Anchorst Road to Anchorst Schools, otherwise than from South to North.

that portion of Anchorst Road, St. Peter Port, from the junction of Rouge Rue to the junction of Guelles Road, St. Peter Port, otherwise than from North to South.

that portion of Rue Europeas, St. Peter Port, from the junction of Guelles Road to the junction of Rouge Rue, St. Peter Port, and Mont Arrive Road, St. Peter Port, otherwise than from West to East.

2. The words "vehicle" and "animal" shall for the purpose of this Regulation have the meanings respectively assigned to them by Article 1 of the Ordonnance ayant rapport au Traffic Vehiculaire en cette Ile, No. X of 1939.

This Regulation means that all traffic using the roads bordering Norman Terrace, Anchorst, shall proceed leaving Norman Terrace on their right hand side.
