IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW 1946

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949

OPEN GENERAL EXPORT LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order 1949, dated the 3rd August, 1949, (a) as amended, the exportation from Guernsey of goods consigned to a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the Board of Administration.

Now, therefore, the Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises and permits:-

1. The exportation from Guernsey to any port or destination other than a port or destination in China, Hong Kong, Macao and Tibet of the goods specified in the Schedule thereto.
2. This Licence shall take effect on the 2nd December, 1954, and may be modified or revoked at any time by the Board of Administration.
