THE IMPORTED EGGS (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1953.

Made 18th December, 1953.

Coming into Operation ... 20th December, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. (1) In this Order -

"Buy" includes offer or agree to buy and "sell" includes offer or agree to sell or expose for sale;

"Eggs" means the eggs in shell of domestic fowls;

"Imported eggs" means eggs which have been imported into the Bailiwick of Guernsey, the place of origin being outside the British Isles.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

2. No person shall sell or buy any imported eggs at a price exceeding the maximum price applicable thereto in accordance with the provisions of the Schedule to this Order.

3. The Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, dated 17th January, 1951 (a) and The Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 5) Order, 1952, dated 29th July, 1952 (b) are hereby revoked.

4. This Order may be cited as The Imported Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 20th day of December, 1953.
