REPEALED by S.I. 9 (1953)

The Animals and Animal Products (Importation) Order, 1953.

The States of Guernsey Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section eleven of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, and of all other powers enabling them on that behalf, hereby order: -

1. For the purposes of this Order the expression "animals" shall include dogs and cats.
2. The importation into the Island from the Island of Jersey of animals, carcasses, fertilisers and feeding stuffs shall be prohibited.
3. Notwithstanding the provisions of the last preceding section, the Committee may at any time, by licence, permit the importation into the Island from the Island of Jersey on such terms and conditions, if any, as they may impose, of a dog or a cat.
4. The Animals and Animal Products (Importation) (No.3) Order, 1952(a), and the Animals and Animal Products (Extension of Definition) Order, 1952(b), shall be repealed.
5. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
6. This Order shall come into operation on the 3rd January, 1953.
