IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY)  
ORDER, 1949, AMENDMENT ORDER, 1953.

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a) shall be amended by the deletion therefrom of the item -  

"Motor Vehicles, that is to say, any mechanically propelled vehicle other than a motor cycle intended or adapted for use on a road."
2. The Delegation of Power to Grant Export Licences (No. 1) Order, 1949, (b) shall be amended by the deletion therefrom of the words -  

"Motor vehicles."
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into force on the 8th day of January, 1953, and may be cited as the "Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment Order, 1953".
