THE UTILITY FURNITURE (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Utility Furniture (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, dated 9th October, 1951 (a), the Utility Furniture (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1952, dated 9th January, 1952 (b) and the Utility Furniture (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1952, dated 25th March, 1952 (c) are hereby revoked.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Utility Furniture (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 24th day of December, 1952.
