THE "NUTTY SLACK COAL" (TEMPORARY RELAXATION)
(GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. During the operation of this Order the Coal Rationing Order, 1946, shall cease to have effect in so far as the supply and acquisition of "Natty Slack Coal" is concerned, provided that such coal shall not be supplied or acquired for horticultural purposes except under and in accordance with the terms of a licence granted by or on behalf of the States' Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the "Natty Slack Coal" (Temporary Relaxation) (Guernsey) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 2nd day of January, 1953.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order frees "Natty Slack Coal" from the provisions of the Coal Rationing Order, 1946, if obtained or supplied for domestic use only. Supplies may only be released for horticultural purposes under the authority of a licence granted by the States' Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities.
