

THE WOMEN'S AND MAIDS' NYLON STOCKINGS (DISTRIBUTORS' MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1953.

Made ... 9th January, 1953.

Coming into Operation ... 12th January, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Women's and Maids' Nylon Stockings (Distributors' Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952 (a) shall have effect as if in paragraph (1) of Article 4, after the definition of "maximum price", there were inserted the following definition:-
 

"nylon" means synthetic linear polyamide fibre, and, without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing words, includes Perlon, Phrilon, Enkalon, Grilon, Mirlon, Amilan, Rilsan and Silon."
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Women's and Maids' Nylon Stockings (Distributors' Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 12th day of January, 1953.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends the Women's and Maids' Nylon Stockings (Distributors' Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952, by inserting a definition of "nylon". The definition expressly includes nylon manufactured under different trade names, such as "Perlon", "Phrilon", "Enkalon", etc.
