THE BACON (PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER, 1952.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Bacon (Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended as follows:-

(a) by substituting in the First Schedule thereto for the entries relating to Gammons or Hams the following:-

- (b) by substituting in the said First Schedule for the fixed wholesale price per cwt. of "50s. 8d." in relation to Cooked, Boneless and Skinless (other than in or ex tins): Gammons or Hams, the fixed wholesale price per cwt. of "75s. 8d.";
- (c) by substituting in the said First Schedule for the fixed wholesale price per cwt. of "43s. 8d." in relation to Cooked, Bone-in and Skinless (other than in or ex tins): Gammons or Hams, the fixed wholesale price per cwt. of "64s. 8d.";
- (d) by substituting in the Second Schedule thereto for the maximum retail price per lb. of "5s. 8½d." in relation to Cooked, Boneless and Skinless (other than in or ex tins) (in slices or pieces): Gammon or Ham, the maximum retail price per lb. of "8s. 0½d.";
- (e) by substituting in the said Second Schedule for the maximum retail price per lb. of "4s. 1½d." in relation to Cooked, Bone-in and Skinless (other than in or ex tins): Whole Gammon or Ham, the maximum retail price per lb. of "6s. 1½d."; and
- (f) by substituting in the said Second Schedule for the maximum retail price per lb. of "4s. 9½d." in relation to Cooked, Boneless and Skinless (other than in or ex tins): Whole Gammon or Ham, the maximum retail price per lb. of "7s. 2½d.".

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

3. This Order may be cited as the Bacon (Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1952; and shall come into operation on the 28th day of December, 1952.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order prescribes increased fixed wholesale and maximum retail prices for Category 'C' Bacon which, if cooked, can now be sold by retail free of rationing restrictions.
