THE BACON (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 2)  
ORDER, 1953.

Made ... .. 21st January, 1953.

Coming into Operation. ... .. 25th January, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended by substituting in the second column of the Schedule thereto (which specifies the amount of the bacon ration) for the amount "5 oz." in relation to each appropriate coupon in a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 and a Form R.B.12 the amount "4 oz."
2. Pursuant to Articles 28 and 30 of the Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952 (c), where a surplus of ham or gammon bacon is held by a retailer, from bacon he is authorised by permit CP.2 or Misc.2 to obtain for supply to his registered customers or to establishments as the case may be, after having supplied the lawful requirements of those customers and establishments the retailer may either:-
  - (a) cook the said surplus ham or gammon bacon and supply it ration free; or
  - (b) supply it ration free uncooked;and any person may obtain any such ham or bacon ration free from the retailer.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
4. This Order may be cited as the Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 25th day of January, 1953.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order reduces from 5 oz. to 4 oz., from 25th January, 1953, the amount of bacon which may be obtained against each appropriate coupon in Ration Books R.B.1 and R.B.2 and Form R.B.12.

At the same time provision is made whereby retailers who hold a surplus of ham or gammon bacon from bacon authorised for supply to registered customers and establishments, after supplying the lawful requirements of registered customers and establishments are permitted to sell such surplus ration free whether cooked or uncooked.
