THE IMPORT DUTIES (No. 27) ORDER (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY), 1953,
DATED 10th FEBRUARY, 1953, MADE BY THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION,
BY VIRTUE OF THE IMPORT DUTIES LAWS (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY),
1932 TO 1947.

WHEREAS the Import Duties Laws (Bailiwick of Guernsey), 1932 to 1947, provide that (subject to the limitation therein provided) the Board of Administration may, by Order, direct that there shall be chargeable on goods imported into the Bailiwick such duties as may be specified in the Order;

AND WHEREAS the said Laws empower the said Board of Administration, by Order, to vary or revoke any duties chargeable by virtue of any previous Order;

Now, therefore, the Board of Administration, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the said Laws and by resolution of the said Board of the 10th February, 1953, does hereby order as follows:-

1. The following goods, that is to say, rope-soled footwear, being footwear the sole of which is made wholly of rope, shall be charged to duty at the rate of 15 per cent ad valorem, notwithstanding the fact that such goods may, in pursuance of the Import Duties (No. 25) Order (Bailiwick of Guernsey) 1951, as amended, be chargeable at a higher rate of duty.
2. The provisions of the Import Duties Laws (Bailiwick of Guernsey), 1932 to 1947, shall apply to the articles set out in this Order and duty shall be charged thereon at the rate set out above.
3. This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (No. 27) Order (Bailiwick of Guernsey) 1953.
4. This Order shall come into operation in the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney on the 16th day of February, 1953, and in the Island of Sark so soon thereafter as the provisions of the said Laws with reference to the putting into operation therein of this Order shall have been complied with.
