The Safety of Employees (Miscellaneous Provisions)  
Ordinance, 1952.

Certificate of Exemption No. 1

Annealing.

Made ... .. 2nd March, 1953  
Coming into Operation ... 2nd March, 1953

The States Labour and Welfare Committee, as the Administering Authority constituted by the States under the Health, Safety and Welfare of Employees Law, 1950, and in pursuance of paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section nine of the Safety of Employees (Miscellaneous Provisions) Ordinance, 1952, hereby exempt the following classes of chain and lifting tackle from the requirements of the said paragraph as to annealing:-

- (1) Chains made of malleable cast iron;
- (2) Plate link chains;
- (3) Chains, rings, hooks, shackles and swivels made of steel or of any non-ferrous metal;
- (4) Pitched chains working on sprocket or pocketed wheels;
- (5) Rings, hooks, shackles and swivels permanently attached to pitched chains, pulley blocks or weighing machines;
- (6) Hooks and swivels having screw-threaded parts or ball-bearings or other case-hardened parts;
- (7) Socket shackles secured to wire ropes by white metal capping;
- (8) Bordeaux connections;
- (9) Any chain or lifting tackle which has been subjected to the heat treatment known as "normalising" instead of annealing.
