Certificate of Exemption No. 8

Steam Boilers - Economisers of the Steaming Type.

Made	2nd March, 1953
Coming into Operation	2nd March, 1953

The States Labour and Welfare Committee, as the Administering Authority constituted by the States under the Health, Safety and Welfare of Employees Law, 1950, and in pursuance of section eighteen of the Safety of Employees (Miscellaneous Provisions) Ordinance, 1952, hereby except economisers of the steaming type from the provisions of paragraph (a) (i) of subsection (1) of section fifteen of the said Ordinance, subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) this exception shall not apply to any such economiser which is fitted with a stop valve or other means of controlling or preventing the free flow of hot water or steam to the steam boiler connected therewith;
- (2) the maximum permissible working pressure of such economiser shall not be less than that of the said steam boiler;
- (3) the safety valve or safety valves of the said steam boiler shall be such as to prevent either the boiler or the economiser being worked at a pressure greater than the maximum permissible working pressure of either.
