SPENT

THE RATIONING (PERSONAL POINTS) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1953.

Made 5th February, 1953.

Coming into Operation. ... 5th February, 1953.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Rationing (Personal Points) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1952 (a) is hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Rationing (Personal Points) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 5th day of February, 1953.
